AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO ENGAGEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NEWPORT AND VULIN WILKINSON LLC

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 2 is to the engagement agreement dated January 16, 2023 between the City of Newport, an Oregon municipal corporation, and Vulin Wilkinson LLC ("Agreement").

Recitals:

- Vulin Wilkinson LLC is providing legal representation for construction defect litigation relating to the Newport Aquatic Center (attached is a copy of the Agreement and August 25, 2023 amendment); and
- 2. City and Vulin Wilkinson LLC desire to increase the cap for legal fees for the above representation from \$100,000 to \$200,000 for ongoing document review and production, depositions, mediation, and other services relating to this litigation.

Terms of Amendment No. 2:

City and Vulin Wilkinson LLC agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

- A. Vulin Wilkinson LLC legal fees in this matter shall not exceed \$200,000.
- B. This Amendment may be executed in counterparts and a signed copy transmitted by facsimile or other electronic means, each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which taken together will constitute one and the same agreement.

Except as expressly set forth herein, all provisions of the Agreement shall continue and remain in full force and effect.
