
INVITATION FOR BIDS

Sealed bids for the construction of the **Big Creek Pump Station** in the City of Newport (Lincoln County), Oregon, will be received by Tim Gross, PE, Public Works Director/City Engineer, at 169 SW Coast Highway, Newport, OR 97365, until **2:00 pm, June 24, 2015** and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud. Bids received after this time will not be accepted. All interested parties are invited to attend. Subcontractor declarations must be delivered to Owner as above no later than **4:00 p.m.** on the day of the bid opening.

A brief description of the scope of work is provided below:

Construct and install a new Big Creek Pump Station that includes the following components: 12-foot diameter precast wet well, valve vault, flow meter with vault, Generator/Electrical Building, new onsite sewers and manholes, civil site improvements, and associated mechanical equipment. Mechanical equipment to include: three approx. 130 HP pumps and associated piping and valving, new approx. 300 kW auxiliary generator, and electrical power and controls to operate the pump station. Construction is to occur with the existing pump station to remain fully operational until switchover to the new station.

Complete construction/installation of the new pump station shall include, but not be limited to, excavation shoring and dewatering system, bypass pumping, erosion and sediment control, excavation and backfill, connection to existing systems and utilities, providing City staff access to existing pump station, along with complete testing of the new pump station as required.

Contractors, vendors, and suppliers wishing to download the specifications and drawings may do so at the ORPIN website. All contractors, vendors, and suppliers interested in the project must register through the ORPIN website so that they may receive addenda and other bidding information that may become available during the advertising and bid period. No other entity or plan center will issue addenda.

No bid will be considered unless fully completed in the manner provided in the Instructions to Bidders, and accompanied by a bid security, executed in favor of the Owner, in the amount not less than 10% of the total amount of the bid.

This contract is for public work and is subject to ORS 279C.800 to 279C.870 regarding prevailing wage rates. Licensing under ORS 468A.710 is not required. The contracting agency may cancel the procurement or reject any or all bids in accordance with ORS 279B.100.

A mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at 10:00 a.m., June 9, 2015, at Newport City Hall, 169 SW Coast Hwy, Newport, OR 97365.
