- I. Call to Order: Ted Jones, Ken Dennis, Alisha Kern, Dave Teem, Bob Hein, Elliott Crowder, Maryann Bozza, Chuck Forinash; no guests in attendance
- II. Approval of Minutes - January minutes approved with no changes
- III. Staff Reports - Ted Jones
  - A. Committee asked when the bike lane on SE Bay Blvd will be striped. Ted said when the intersection is redone (after the drainage is worked out); Tim will address the task force recommendations when he gets the final TIA, which should be by this summer. The Committee offered feedback:
    - The committee requests that it be done before then. It's a visibility issue with truck traffic, and a community safety issue on a very busy intersection; it should be considered separately than the drainage issue.
    - Since is an existing bike lane that has not been maintained as such, it is as such a liability for the City. It should be done thermoplastic but paint OK if it's temporary. In general, sharrows should be thermoplastic not painted, but for low traffic routes or temporary purposes (i.e. SE Bay Blvd) it should be considered. Can use the bicycle portion of the sharrow to paint inside the bike lane; the Committee offers to help as volunteers.
    - Committee offered to request the striping in writing.
  - B. Ravine at end of Park St looking for route to drill; three choices being considered. Consultant is looking at getting wetland permits and taking it through there. This has to do with the shortcut on Coast St. Timetable: going to bid this summer and should be under construction; if the wetland option is not used, it would preclude installation of the trail. Committee will ask for an update in several weeks.
