**D. Old Business**

In attendance were Kathy Kuebbling and Betty Krause (by phone) representing the Friends of the Newport Senior, Vada Robinson representing the Association. and John Baker. Groups reported. Vada, Kathy and Nancy from the fiscal and usage group have completed their tasks and will join in another committee. Mike and Peggy reported about both the exterior and interior signage. Peggy said the interior signage should be up by next meeting. The group looked at the exterior signage and most suggested some other designs be submitted. Mike Rickus asked Ann Way about the art partnership with Oregon Coast Community College. Peggy reported that now that the formal name of the center had been changed that the committee also needed to change its name. Mike Rickus and Peggy will work on this.

2016 trip list was talked about. It was suggested that outside shopping trips be re labeled to just the destination place and to encourage more local trips for unique shopping opportunities. John Baker said he would be able to lead a trip for 2016 and will visit the office to schedule one.

A celebration for Lincoln County residents who are 90+ age group is in the planning stages. Peggy is seeking people and business to partner with. She hopes to celebrate in May as May is older American Month.
