B. Minutes of the August 19th, 2013 meeting were read and approved.

D. Old Business:

1. Parking Review. Mike recommended angle parking behind Chevron station. It was noted that out of 12 days only 1 unmarked car has used the new PD space three times. Jim mentioned that non senior center users are once again parking in our lot. This is a major concern for users of the senior center. Peggy mentioned that the center had 50 parking spaces prior to the Naterlin Center remodel, after the remodel the PD took approximately 25 for PD. Jim mentioned that the city may be once again reviewing parking options. It was recommended to invite Public Works director, Tim Gross to the next meeting to visits with the advisory about parking and water issues at the SC.

E. New Business:
