- B. Minutes of the June 17th, 2013 meeting were read and approved.
- C. Citizens Comments
- D. Old Business:
1. Reviewed Sign placement and received authorization for placement from City engineer Greg Schaecher. Price quote included installation.
 2. Ramp way to City Hall has been repaired.
- E. New Business:
1. Pool Update
Jim Protiva updated the Advisory regarding putting the pool on the ballot in November. He will seek approval from the Newport City Council at tonight's meeting. Jim said if the pool was voted in that it could impact parking.
 2. Parking
Discussion ensued regarding the amount of Senior Center parking available. Prior to the Naterlin building re-model there were approx. 50 spaces for senior usage. The PD has 30 after moving to the Naterlin/City Hall. The 60+ center currently has 20 spaces. The street on the West side of the 60+ building could be vertical parking to increase spaces.

Motion made and seconded to petition council to review parking potential for the 60+ and off street parking adjacent to the 60+ lot on both the North and West side of the 60+ center.
 3. Van Maintenance
Eldon Suggested to assign someone to ensure regular van maintenance occur. The office will instigate a log to record of recommended maintenance and schedule through the City shops.
 4. Staff Report
2012-2013 over 43 different program or activities offered throughout the year.
Served over 17,500 persons at the 60+ Center.
Total programs offered in June 31 Fitness 14, Social 9, and Educational 8.
