The draft ocean bioaccumulation survey report was distributed to those present. DiFilippis asked that questions regarding the report be submitted, via e-mail, to Hawker by May 15. Hawker will send the written questions to Dr. Henkel, who will respond to the questions at the next meeting.

Plybon noted that he believed that OSU had been tasked with preparing an educational component. He added that there needs to be a fair interpretation in the executive summary, as people might read it and fail to understand it.

Lawson noted that it would be helpful to have a figure or bar chart that shows how the findings relate to the concerns regarding human consumption of seafood; something that indicates that this is what was found, and this is what could be worrisome.

It was also suggested that a graph be prepared regarding the reference locations.

It was asked whether there is a complete set of data relative to Table 4.
