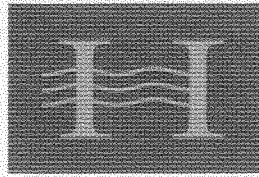

Thank you for understanding and your help.

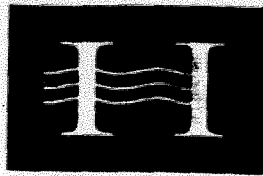
