The City of Newport is seeking a motivated individual for the position of Engineering Technician I, II, or III. The successful applicant will be hired at the appropriate range and step depending on qualifications. This is a full-time (40 hours per week)/regular/non-exempt position, and is part of the Newport Employee's Association collective bargaining agreement. Salary range is \$2,955.47 - \$4,290.31 monthly depending on qualifications.

The position requires: the ability to carry out the essential functions of the position; the ability to coordinate and review certain aspects of projects; the ability to apply CAD and GIS techniques to prepare drawings and maps, plans, and records; the ability to perform detailed work thoroughly, neatly, accurately and efficiently; the ability to properly use and care for equipment, instruments, hardware and software; the ability to read and interpret standard field notes, engineering and construction drawings, and technical specifications; the ability to perform a variety of engineering computations; the ability to read and interpret maps, aerial photographs, mapping coordinates, survey documents, legal documents boundary information, right-of-way information, and construction blueprints; and the ability to conduct field data gathering and inspections.
