The City of Newport Oregon is seeking a reliable, experienced professional Water Treatment Plant Operator II. This is a non-exempt, full-time/regular position with a salary range of \$3,257.52 - \$4,290.31, plus excellent benefits.

This position primarily operates, maintains and repairs water supply and treatment facilities. The ideal candidate will be a critical thinker who can troubleshoot, maintain, and repair electrical and mechanical equipment throughout the plant. Experience operating membrane filtration systems preferred.
