OPEN HOUSE DRAFT DESIGN OF US 101: 32ND TO 35TH STREET IMPROVEMENTS

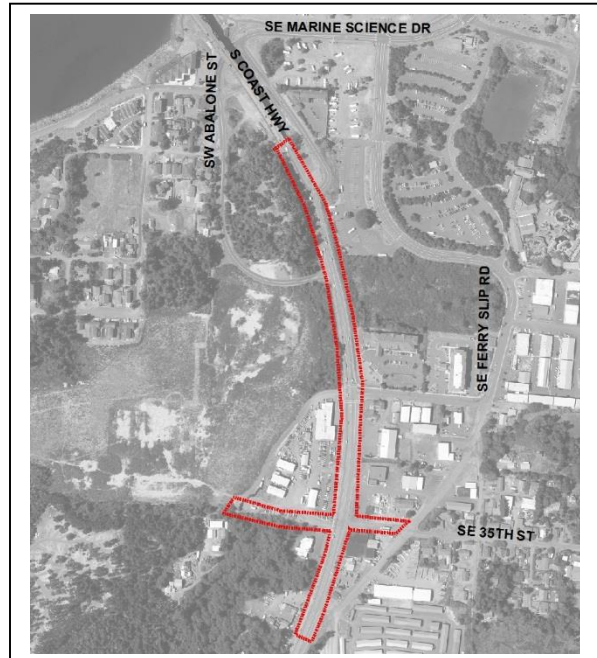

Please join us to learn about, or share your views on the design drawings for planned improvements to US 101 and 35th Street in South Beach. The work will include:

- Construction of a signalized intersection at US 101 and 35th Street
- Elimination of the traffic signal and channelization of US 101 and 32nd Street
- Closure of the US 101 and Ferry Slip Road Intersection
- Installation of bike and pedestrian facilities along US 101 between the Yaquina Bay Bridge and Ferry Slip Road
- Undergrounding of overhead utilities along US 101 and Ferry Slip Road



Staff with the City of Newport, the Oregon Department of Transportation and the consulting firm Quincy Engineering will be present to answer questions. In addition to drawings showing the preliminary design of planned improvements, information will be available outlining the overall design and construction schedule.
