**CITY OF NEWPORT TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING
FOR COMMUNITY INPUT ON
AN ORDINANCE REGARDING THE UNLAWFUL TRANSFER
OF MATERIAL GOODS FROM A VEHICLE
ON A STREET OR PUBLIC RIGHT-OF-WAY
