PUBLIC HEARING
ON PROPOSED ELECTRONIC MESSAGING SIGN
TO BE LOCATED AT HIGHWAY 101 AND HURBERT STREET

The Newport City Council will hold a public hearing on a request to place an electronic messaging sign on the northwest corner of the intersection of Highway 101 and Hurbert Street.
