ORDINANCE NO. 2012

AN ORDINANCE ELIMINATING THE  
NEWPORT URBAN RENEWAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) Chapter 457 provides that a governing body of a municipality shall, in an ordinance adopted under ORS 457.035, identify how the powers of an urban renewal agency are to be exercised; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted such an ordinance on April 2, 2007 (Ord. No. 1910), transferring urban renewal agency authority from the Newport Development Commission to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 1910 renamed the Newport Development Commission as the Newport Urban Renewal Advisory Committee, maintained its current membership and terms, and established that the Urban Renewal Advisory Committee was to meet at least annually or when needed to advise the Council regarding major policy issues relating to urban renewal and administration of urban renewal plans; and

WHEREAS, the Urban Renewal Advisory Committee is inactive and the terms of membership have expired; and

WHEREAS, the City Council no longer sees the need to retain the Urban Renewal Advisory Committee as a standing committee, recognizing that at any point it may form a taskforce under the process outlined in the Newport Municipal Code to advise on major urban renewal policy matters.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF NEWPORT ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Sub-section 2.05.035 of the Newport Municipal Code describing the membership and role of the Urban Renewal Advisory Committee is hereby deleted and related resolutions or bylaws rendered null and void.
