Resolution No. 3532

A Resolution Creating a Task Force
Related to the City's Business License & Room Tax Codes

Findings:

The City's Business License and Room Tax Codes require updating. Several community entities and individuals are interested in being involved in the updating process.

Based on these Findings, THE CITY OF NEWPORT RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. A Business License and Room Tax (BLRT) Task Force is created which shall consist of either five (5) or seven (7) members. Members of the Task Force shall be chosen by interested citizenry at a public meeting and be confirmed by the City Council.

Section 2. The Task Force will meet as necessary and be tasked with the following:

- a) Assist the City in updating the City's Business License and Room Tax Codes which includes reviewing, evaluating, and making recommendations to the City Council regarding the Codes;
- b) Assist city staff, as requested, by recommending processes and procedures for implementation by the city to assist with the successful implementation of the revised Codes; and
- c) Perform such other tasks related to the subject matter herein as may be requested by the City Council.

Section 3. The Task Force shall be in effect beginning on the date of confirmation by the City Council and until June 1, 2011, or such other date as may be established by the City Council. The Task Force shall be supported by city staff.

Section 4. This Resolution is effective upon adoption.
