

RESOLUTION NO. 3575

A RESOLUTION APPOINTING AN ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR THE CITY CENTER COMMERCIAL PARKING DISTRICT

FINDINGS:

1. On October 3, 2011, the City Council of the City of Newport adopted Ordinance No. 2020 establishing an economic improvement district for parking system improvements in the Bayfront area and assessing a surcharge on business license fees for businesses within the district to fund said improvements; and.
2. The new district, identified as the "Bayfront Commercial Parking District," is effective November 3, 2011; and
3. When creating the Bayfront Commercial Parking District the Council established that an advisory committee was to be formed to develop a plan for the completion of improvements and to allocate expenditure of monies for activities within the scope of the plan; and
4. Ordinance No. 2020 requires that the Committee consist of an even number of members, with the specific number to be determined by the City Council; and
5. Ordinance No. 2020 further requires that the Committee include one person conducting business within the district; one member of the fishing community; and one representative from the Port of Newport. The ordinance further requires that Council seek to ensure that neither tourism nor fishing business interests are disproportionately represented; and
6. Press releases were issued by the city, on October 5, 2011, November 1, 2011, and November 15, 2011, seeking applications from citizens interested in serving on the advisory committee for the Bayfront Commercial Parking District; and
7. Applications were received from seven (7) individuals, Michael Pettis, Gary Ripka, Don Mathews, Debbie Hayter, Gabrielle McEntee-Wilson, Janet Webster, and Cris Torp; and
8. Michael Pettis and Gary Ripka are members of the fishing community; Don Mann represents the Port of Newport; and Don Mathews, Debbie Hayter, Gabrielle McEntee-Wilson, Janet Webster, and Cris Torp conduct business in the district; and
9. If a vacancy is created subsequent to the initial appointments, the vacancy will be filled by Mayoral appointment with ratification by the City Council.

THE CITY OF NEWPORT RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. (Appointee names will be inserted once Council makes the appointments) are hereby appointed as the advisory committee for the Bayfront Commercial Parking District.

Section 2. The foregoing appointment is for a five (5) year period ending November 3, 2016.

Section 3. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon passage.


