Location: Highway 101 at Highway 20

Date/Time: 01/05/2013 at 2:00 a.m.

Suspect: Male, adult, wearing a dark colored hooded jacket, light colored pants

Details: On 01/05/2013, at approximately 2:00 a.m., a Newport Police Officer encountered a stabbing victim with a group of witnesses at the intersection of Highways 101 and 20. The victim, Daniel Brown, age 23 of Newport, had suffered a severe knife wound to one leg, and two more stab wounds to his leg and back. He was treated on scene by Newport Fire Department personnel and transported to Samaritan Pacific Communities Hospital in Newport. He underwent emergency surgery and was admitted. He is expected to survive his injuries.

Newport Police Officers and Lincoln County Deputies searched the area for the suspect, who was seen fleeing the area on foot. He was not located. After interviewing witnesses throughout the day, and viewing surveillance recordings from area businesses as well as the camera on the dashboard of a patrol car, further suspect information was developed. However, the suspect has not been identified or taken into custody. He was last seen running east bound from the area near the Shell gas station.
