Incident: Reward Offered for Bank Robbery Information **Case#: 09N-02140**

Location: Umpqua Bank, 1250 N. Coast Highway, Newport

Date/Time: 11/13/2009 at 5:29 p.m.

Suspect: White/Male/Adult, 50 to 60 years of age, 5'6" to 5'8" tall, slim build. Last seen wearing a blue-gray colored stocking cap pulled over a light colored baseball cap, large frame sunglasses, light colored zip-up windbreaker jacket, and light colored sweat pants.

Details: The Newport Police Department and the FBI are offering a reward for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the suspect in this robbery.

On 11/13/2009 at about 5:29 PM, employees of the Umpqua Bank on Hwy 101 in Newport reported that they had just been robbed at gun point by a single male suspect. He fled the area on foot with an undisclosed amount of money. The robbery was witnessed by three bank employees and a customer who walked into the bank at the time the incident was occurring.
