Resisting Arrest

Location: 200 Block of NW 13th Street

Date/Time: 07/31/2011 at 12:50 a.m.

Suspect: Carissa Marie Laprall, age 19 of no known address

Details: On 07/31/2011, at about 12:50 a.m., Newport Police Officers responded to multiple reports of a female screaming in a field in the 200 block of NW 13th Street. Officers encountered a female, naked from the waist down, running across the field with two dogs on a leash. She was identified as Carissa Laprall, who told officers she was homeless and traveling through the area. Laprall was intoxicated, and it was quickly determined that she had not been injured and was not being menaced by anyone.

Laprall refused to dress herself, even after her pants were found in the field. Laprall continued to yell obscenities at officers and continued to refuse to dress herself. Laprall was arrested for Disorderly Conduct II and, after being placed in handcuffs, resisted officers' efforts to walk her to a patrol car. While on the way to the jail, Laprall intentionally hit her head against the interior of the car, and kicked at the windows of the patrol car. Laprall was lodged at the Lincoln County Jail on charges of Disorderly Conduct II, and Resisting Arrest. She was also cited for Minor in Possession. Her bail for the criminal charges was set at \$22,500.

The two dogs were taken to the Lincoln County Animal Shelter.
