**Incident:** Failure to Register as a Sex Offender **Case#: 12N-01632**

**Location:** Little Creek Apartments, Newport

**Date/Time:** 09/06/2012 at 5:30 p.m.

**Suspect:** Patrick Wayne Maki, age 37 of Newport

**Details:** On 09/06/2012, Newport Police Officers began receiving information about a male subject living in Newport and using alias names to hide his identity as a convicted felon and Registered Sex Offender in the State of Florida. The Newport Police Officer investigating the information with the Monroe County Sheriff's Office in Florida, learned that Patrick Wayne Maki, age 37 of Newport, had been convicted in Florida of felony sex offenses involving young girls. He had last registered as a Sex Offender in Florida in 2011, and fled Florida shortly thereafter. The investigation revealed Maki had travelled to Hawaii. He was now living in the Newport area with an adult female and her two minor children. He was using the alias name of Patrick McFinn. He had been working for a local charter fishing company since at least January of 2012. When contacted, Maki gave police his name as Jared Newman, but eventually admitted his true name and date of birth.

Maki was lodged at the Lincoln County Jail on charges of Failure to Register as a Sex Offender, and Providing False Information to a Police Officer. Florida officials were made aware of his arrest and further charges are anticipated.
