**Suspects:** White, Todd T., age 24 of Toledo  
Moorehouse, William R., age 19 of Toledo

**Details:** On 06/17/2010 at 6:00 p.m., Newport Police Officers were dispatched to a report of subjects harassing people on the beach near Nye Beach. The two suspects reportedly brandished a knife, threatening a group of people and placing the group in fear for their lives. After menacing the group of people, the suspects fled the beach into the grassy area above the beach.

Officers from the Newport Police Department and Lincoln County Sheriff's Office began searching the area. After an extensive search, the two suspects, identified as Todd White and William Moorhouse, were located hiding in the bushes. White and Moorhouse were taken into custody. During the custody process, White struggled with officers and resisted arrest. White and Moorhouse were eventually escorted from the beach and transported to the Lincoln County Jail.

White was lodged on five counts of Menacing, three counts of Resisting Arrest, and Disorderly Conduct II. His bail was set at \$130,000.00.

Moorhouse was lodged on three counts of Menacing, and Disorderly Conduct II. His bail was set at \$55,000.00.
