**Suspect:** Troy Paul Holmes, 22 years  
Newport Transient

**Details:** At about 3:08 AM, Newport Police Officers and Lincoln County Sheriff's Deputies responded to J. C. Market in Newport on a report of a subject creating a disturbance and brandishing a knife. When confronted, the suspect failed to comply with orders from officers. The suspect posed a continuing serious and immediate threat to the officers. Non-lethal force was not effective and he was shot by a deputy. The suspect was given immediate first aid by officers and medical personnel at the scene, and was subsequently transported to the hospital. As of this time the suspect is in surgery and his condition is unknown.

The Lincoln County Major Crime Team, made up of the Oregon State Police, Lincoln City Police Department, Newport Police Department, Lincoln County Sheriff's Office and the Lincoln County District Attorney's Office is handling the investigation. Pursuant to the Lincoln County Deadly Physical Force Plan (Senate Bill 111), for this incident, the Lincoln City Police Department has been designated as the lead agency. The names of the officers involved in this incident are not being released at this time. Chief Mark J. Miranda is handling all media contacts at this time.
