**Date/Time:** 11/29/2009 at 4:11 a.m.

**Suspects:** Vidal Rene Davis, age 22 of Siletz  
Martin Bautista Bautista, age 21 of Newport

**Details:** On 11/29/2009, at about 4:11 a.m., Newport Police Officers were dispatched to the Willar's Motel on Highway 101. A caller was reporting that two men had broken a window, and were possibly burglarizing the shop area of the motel. When the first officer arrived, he encountered a male walking across the parking lot carrying an armload of power tools. The male subject ran from the officer, and was taken into custody a short distance away. When the building was checked, a second suspect was found hiding under a staircase in the shop. The two suspects were identified as Vidal Rene Davis, age 22, and Martin Bautista Bautista, age 21. Both initially gave officers false names, but after arriving at the Lincoln County Jail their true identities were verified. Three felony warrants were found for Davis' arrest from Lane and Marion Counties. Davis was also found to be on felony probation in Lane County due to a previous conviction for Robbery.

Davis was lodged in the Lincoln County Jail on charges of Burglary II, Criminal Mischief III, Theft II, Giving False Information to a Police Officer, and felony warrants that charge him with Violation of a Conditional Release on an arrest for Robbery III in Lane County, Failure to Appear I in Lane County, and Possession of Dangerous Drugs in Marion County. His total bail was set at \$387,500.

Bautista was lodged in the Lincoln County Jail on charges of Burglary II, two counts of Criminal Mischief III, Theft II, and Giving False Information to a Police Officer. His bail was set at \$95,000.
