Location: Umpqua Bank, 1250 N Coast Hwy

Date/Time: 11/13/2009 at 5:29 p.m.

Suspect: White/Male/Adult, 50 to 60 years of age, 5'6" to 5'8" tall, slim build, last seen wearing a blue-gray colored stocking cap pulled over a light colored baseball cap, large frame sunglasses, light colored zip up windbreaker jacket, light colored sweat pants.

Details: On 11/13/2009 at about 5:29 p.m., Newport Police Officers were contacted by employees of the Umpqua Bank on Hwy 101 to report that they had just been robbed at gun point by a single male suspect. The suspect fled the area on foot with an undisclosed sum of money. The robbery was witnessed by three bank employees and a customer who walked into the bank at the time the incident was occurring.

Newport Police were assisted by deputies from the Lincoln County Sheriff's Office in searching the area for the suspect, but he was not located.
