 Sink hole repeatedly forms around a manhole at the Embarcadero




#### BAY/MOORE - SEPTEMBER 2011

- Specifically addressed area around Bay Boulevard and SE Moore Drive




## BAY/MOORE - JANUARY 2013

     Boulevard




#### BAY/MOORE - JANUARY 2013

## BAY/MOORE - AUGUST 2013


• Study shows a complex drainage area and two separate main tributaries






## BAY/MOORE - AUGUST 2013




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

 Realignment of the intersection at SE Bay Boulevard and SE Moore Drive









- City begins cross-cutting process
- Crosscutting is the process of working with all of the different environmental agencies to address concerns – culminates with the submittal and hopefully approval of a Joint Permit Application
  - Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife
  - Army Corp of Engineers
  - National Marine Fisheries
  - Department of Environmental Quality
  - Department of State Lands

#### BAY/MOORE - MARCH 2015

- City submits JointPermit Application155 pages
- Received word last week that agencies have everything they need
- Waiting for them to complete the paperwork and we should have our permit





- Construction begins in summer of 2016
- Dredging at the Embarcadero will need to take place during the in-water work window in November 2016
- Project funded through a CWSRF Loan through the DEQ \$2.6M
