1. Does the above project currently have an estimated value, mobilization date, and completion date?

<u>Response</u>: The estimated value and schedule information will be included in the Request for Proposals (RFP).

2. How does the City intend to proceed with the next phase of this solicitation once the shortlist has been determined, proposal only or proposal with pricing (some level of design will be required to provide pricing)?

<u>Response</u>: The RFP will include a request for pricing on EJCDC form D-425 Price Proposal Form. All available information for the existing underbay infrastructure and previous site investigative work will be provided in the RFP. More information on the RFP process will also be included in the RFP.

- Has the City engaged an Owner's Engineer to support them with this solicitation?
 <u>Response</u>: The City has not engaged an Owner's Engineer at this time, but may choose to do so in the future.
- 4. Contractor requests that project key personnel resumes be omitted from the 12-page response limit. The RFQ identifies Qualifications of Key Personnel including Subcontractors to comprise 20% of the SOQ scoring and the resumes would comprise a disproportionate amount of the page limit regardless of how condensed we can present the information.

<u>Response</u>: RFQ Article 4.01 states that Standard Form (SF) 330 documents are not included in the total page count. SF 330 Section E includes Resumes of Key Personnel Proposed for this Contract, therefore resumes are not counted in the total page count.
