### **CONSENT CALENDAR**

### **ADDITIONS/DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA**

**Photography Issue.** Kuhl introduced the agenda item. She stated she had been contacted by a photographer that used to work for the News-Times who wanted payment for use of her photos. Burke said he is taking care of the issue. Michel asked next month that Burke share the new agreement with the committee regarding the photos.

**KFIR.** Tucker introduced the agenda item. She asked if the committee wanted to continue to table the item or drop the renewal.

MOTION was made by Ferry, seconded by Crowder, not to continue with KFIR. The motion carried unanimously in a voice vote.

**Scenic Byways.** Burke introduced the agenda item. He suggested the committee recommend inclusion in the publication for \$5,700.

MOTION was made by Ferry, seconded by Crowder, to recommend approval of the Scenic Byways proposal. The motion carried unanimously in a voice vote.
