| CITY CENTER DESIGN REVIEW DISTRICT FORM BASED CODE CONCEPTS. | Marcy McInelly, AIA, with Urbsworks, Inc., presented final draft of a form-based code concept for the City Center area. Hanselman joined the meeting at 6:07 p.m. The Commission discussed how "Retail Ready" frontage standards would apply exclusively to new buildings and reviewed architectural features. The City Center Design Review District was considered, along with an evaluation of traditional downtown zone standards. Public realm street standards and cross sections were examined, followed by a discussion on appropriate residential setbacks. The Commission discussed how SW Hurbert Street would be a parklet street with tree islands, while SW Alder and SW Lee Streets would be designation as festival or plaza streets. They requested a desire to see the width of pedestrian spaces and considered the difference between commercial and residential alleys. Development and design standards were reviewed, with emphasis placed on the need for clear and objective design standards. Base zone development standards were examined, along with |
