BANNER & PENNANT POLE CONTACT AGREEMENT

	THIS AGREEMENT, made this	s <u><i>201</i>-</u> day	of Octo	ber	, 202	22 by and	betweer	the
CENTR	AL LINCOLN PEOPLE'S UTILITY	DISTRICT	(hereinafter	called th	ne "District"), and the	City of N	ewport
(hereir	nafter called the "City");							

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, District owns certain utility poles within the boundaries of the City; and

WHEREAS, City desires to have attached to said poles what are commonly known as "banners"

or "pennants"; and

WHEREAS, the City has identified the pole contacts necessary for said banners or pennants, described herein as Exhibit A; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined that said described pole contacts will not interfere with the operation of the District's facilities; and

WHEREAS, District desires to cooperate with the City's request to place said banners, pennants and necessary banded brackets (contacts) on said poles;

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- The District hereby agrees to permit the City to construct, maintain and remove banners, pennants and necessary banded brackets, located and described as in Exhibit B.
- The City hereby agrees that the brackets installed upon the District's poles shall be
 constructed in accordance with the specifications contained in the Exhibit B, and by this
 reference made a part hereof.

- 3. The City hereby agrees that the brackets hereinabove described shall at all times be constructed, operated and maintained in accordance with the laws of the State of Oregon, the specifications, rules and regulations of the District, and the National Electrical Safety Code promulgated by the United States Bureau of Standards.
- 4. The City agrees that the installation, maintenance, operation and removal of the banners, pennants and brackets will be done by qualified personnel. City agrees that in cases which, in the sole discretion of the District, present a hazard to personnel, said installation, maintenance and removal will be done by qualified District personnel at the City's expense.
- 5. The City hereby agrees that the construction, operation and maintenance of the City's banners, pennants and brackets, shall be without cost or expense of the District, though under the general supervision and subject to the approval of the District, and subject to such rules and regulations as the District may from time to time prescribe.
- 6. The City hereby agrees to assume all risk of loss, damage and injury to its banners, pennants and brackets or personnel which may result from City's presence on the District's poles.
- 7. The City hereby agrees that any and all damage or injury to District property in the construction, operation or maintenance of its banners, pennants and brackets will be immediately repaired by the City under the supervision and the satisfaction of the District.
- 8. City agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the District, its successors and assigns against any and all claims, suits, actions, debts, damages, costs, charges, expenses (including court cost and attorneys' fees) arising from any and all liability, losses and damages of any nature from whatever sources arising out of the design, installation, placement and maintenance of said banners, pennants, and brackets on said poles, except to the extent attributable to the fault of District, its employees, agents or representatives, or to District's breach of this agreement. City

- agrees to provide liability insurance naming the Distract as an additional insured in the minimum amounts of \$500,000.00 for any number of claims arising out of a single accident or occurrence.
- City shall furnish to the District proof of such insurance reasonably satisfactory to District and shall provide the District with thirty (30) days written notice prior to any cancellation to change in coverage.
- 10. City agrees to design, install, place and maintain said banners, pennants and brackets pursuant to any specifications, regulations or guidelines which the District may promulgate. Any additions or modifications by City shall require District approval prior to implementation. District reserves the right to decline permission of the use to District's poles for any reason whatsoever. In the interests of safety, the District hereby reserves the right to remove any banners, pennants or brackets from District's poles without prior notice.
- This agreement shall continue in full force and effect until revoked by either party upon thirty (30) days written notice.
- 12. In the event that either party is required to retain the services of an attorney to enforce the terms of this agreement, the parties agree that the prevailing party shall be entitled to reasonable attorneys' fees, cost and disbursements.
- 13. City hereby agrees that on or before the termination of this agreement, the City will remove, under the District's supervision, all of its property from the District's poles and restore the same to a condition satisfactory to the District; however, reasonable wear and tear, damage by the elements, or circumstances over which to the City has no control, is excepted.
- 14. City hereby agrees that in the event of pole replacement or relocation all contacts will be transferred by the City under the supervision and to the satisfaction of the District's representatives. The expense of such transfer shall be borne by the City.

- 15. City agrees that the continued location of the poles carrying City's banners, pennants and brackets covered by this agreement, cannot be guaranteed by the District. City agrees that in case the District must relocate poles City will provide other support for the banners and pennants or will move said items and brackets to the relocated pole at City's expense.
- 16. It is understood by both parties the City may assign its rights hereunder subject to the express written authorization of District. Such authorization shall not be unreasonably withheld. The authorization to assign shall not relieve City of the duties contained in this agreement. Any such authorizations shall be attached to this agreement as additional exhibits.



or representatives, or to District's breach of this agreement. City agrees to provide liability insurance naming the District as an additional insured in the minimum amount of \$500,000.00 for any number of claims arising out of a single accident or occurrence.

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
