#### CITY OF NEWPORT

This Amendment No. 1 ("Amendment") to Loan Agreement No. R68934 (the "Loan Agreement") is executed between the State of Oregon acting by and through its Department of Environmental Quality ("DEQ") and the City of Newport (the "Borrower"), effective as of the Effective Date indicated below.
