AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NEWPORT AND WATER STRATEGIES, LLC

THIS AMENDMENT is to the above-described agreement dated August 15, 2022 between the City of Newport, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon ("City"), and WATER STRATEGIES, LLC ("Consultant").

WHEREAS, the above-described agreement ("Agreement") provides, in part, that the agreement may be extended by mutual agreement of the parties; and

WHEREAS, Consultant is providing services related to federal legislative affairs advocacy; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to extend the Agreement until June 30, 2024, and to enter into a scope of work for fiscal year 2023-2024.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree to amend the Agreement, as provided for in section 27, as follows, effective on the date of the last signature below:

- 1. The Agreement is hereby extended until June 30, 2024.
- 2. The Scope of Work and fee w/payment schedule for the Agreement is hereby amended to include the attached document for fiscal year 2023-2024 in the amount of \$60,000.
- 3. This Amendment may be executed in counterparts and a signed copy transmitted by facsimile or other electronic means, each of which will be deemed an original, but all of which taken together will constitute one and the same agreement.

Except as expressly set forth herein, all provisions of the Agreement shall continue and remain in full force and effect.

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FEDERAL ADVOCACY AGREEMENT

This agreement for federal advocacy services is between the city of Newport, an Oregon city incorporated pursuant to Oregon Revised Statute Chapter 221 ("NEWPORT"), and Water Strategies, a District of Columbia limited liability company ("WATER STRATEGIES"). NEWPORT seeks lobbying assistance to pursue federal funding to build a reservoir. WATER STRATEGIES is qualified and experienced in managing, promoting, tracking, and advocating for federal legislation and agency programming solutions on water-related issues involving the U.S. Congress, federal agencies, and organizations that work in western water.

The parties therefore agree as follows:

- 1. SCOPE OF SERVICES. WATER STRATEGIES shall
 - Work with NEWPORT to develop a work plan to guide and develop advocacy efforts;
 - Monitor and report on relevant water and appropriations legislation and regulatory developments;
 - Draft and deliver letters to inform delegation and committee members of NEWPORT's needs and positions;
 - Work with NEWPORT officials and consultants to strategically leverage federal and non-federal funds for the completion of the Big Creek Dam and various other wastewater projects;
 - Schedule meetings with key federal agency officials, members of Congress, and congressional committee staff in Washington, DC; and
 - Provide NEWPORT the opportunity to suggest articles in *Municipal Water Leader* magazine.
- 2. PAYMENT FOR SERVICES. For and in consideration of the services to be provided by WATER STRATEGIES, NEWPORT shall pay WATER STRATEGIES as follows:
 - a. A monthly retainer fee of at \$5,000 (\$60,000 a year) shall be rendered by NEWPORT on or before the 1st of each month;
 - b. Reimbursement, preapproved by NEWPORT, of necessary expenses at actual cost, including, but not limited to: document production, overnight delivery, courier services, business meals, and out-of-town travel. In-town travel will not be billed for, with the exception of those expenses required to accompany NEWPORT members. Reimbursement of expenditures for entertainment or hosting shall not be made and such expenditures are not authorized by this agreement.
