RESOLUTION NO. 3880
A RESOLUTION INITIATING THE NAMING OF
THE PROP SHOP AT THE NEWPORT PERFORMING ARTS CENTER
TO THE DON AND ANN DAVIS PROP SHOP

Findings:

WHEREAS, Chapter 2.35.040 of the Newport Municipal Code provides that the Newport City Council may, by resolution, initiate the naming and renaming of small buildings and components of real property or buildings with an occupancy of less than 50 persons; and

WHEREAS, the Oregon Coast Council for the Arts has requested that the City Council initiate, by adoption of this resolution, the naming of the Prop Shop at the Newport Performing Arts Center to the Don and Ann Davis Prop Shop; and

WHEREAS, if Council adopts this resolution, a public hearing on the naming of the Performing Arts Center Prop Shop to the Don and Ann Davis Prop Shop, would be held at the April 20, 2020 City Council meeting, to allow the public to comment on the proposed naming; and

WHEREAS, if Council adopts this resolution, notice of the public hearing before the City Council will be placed in the March 20, 2020 edition of the Newport News Times.

Based on these findings,


THE CITY OF NEWPORT RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council of the City of Newport, by adoption of Resolution No. 3880, formally initiates the naming of the Performing Arts Center Prop Shop to the Don and Ann Davis Prop Shop, and directs staff to schedule a public hearing on this request for the April 6, 2020 City Council meeting, and further, to provide a notice of public hearing on the naming of this facility, in the March 20, 2020 edition of the Newport News Times.

Section 2. This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.


