A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A COMPREHENSIVE SCHEDULE OF FEES AND CHARGES FOR THE 2021/2022 FISCAL YEAR AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 3894 IN ITS ENTIRETY

Whereas, the City of Newport enacted Resolution number 3894 for the 2020/2021 Fiscal Year which established the City fees and charges for different departments and activities; and

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The Comprehensive Schedule of Fees and Charges, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby approved and establishes the fees and charges for City services.

SECTION 2. Resolution No. 3894 is repealed in its entirety effective July 1, 2021.

SECTION 3. Resolution No. 3920 will become effective on July 1, 2021.
