

RESOLUTION NO. 3971
A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING BUSINESS VENDING AREAS
ON PUBLIC PROPERTY AND RIGHTS-OF-WAY
WITHIN THE CITY OF NEWPORT

WHEREAS, Newport Municipal Code Chapter 4.10 sets out standards for vending along streets, sidewalks and other public places; and

WHEREAS, such standards provide that the City Council, by resolution, may establish designated business vending areas, including the size limitations and number of stands permitted within a given area; and

WHEREAS, the City Council last amended its list of designated vending areas in 2021 with Resolution No. 3930; and

WHEREAS, one of the designated locations, adjacent to the Hatfield Pump Station, has proven to be best suited for use as public parking; and

WHEREAS, alternative locations, on the opposite side of SW Bay Boulevard along the boardwalk, are available and suitable for use by vendors, and will provide pedestrians with better access to vendors than the Hatfield Pump Station location.

THE CITY OF NEWPORT RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Designated business vending areas for fixed stands shall not exceed 100 square feet, and are limited to that portion of the Nye Beach Turnaround property depicted on Exhibit A, and the Old Fern Plant and Boardwalk on the Bayfront, as depicted on Exhibit B, with the following being the maximum number of business license vending endorsements that are to be available at any given time:


- (a) Nye Beach Turnaround - Three (3) licenses.
- (b) Bayfront- Boardwalk- Three (3) licenses.
- (c) Bayfront-Old Fern Plant- Six (6) licenses.

Section 2. Designated business vending areas for mobile stands are limited to marked public parking spaces with a two (2) hour time limit, or longer in the City Center, Bayfront and Nye Beach parking districts, as defined in NMC Section 14.14.100. The maximum number of business license vending endorsements that are to be available at any given time shall be as follows:

- (a) Bayfront District- Four (4) licenses.
- (b) Nye Beach District- Four (4) licenses.
- (c) City Center District - Four (4) licenses.

Section 3. This resolution repeals and replaces Resolution No. 3930 and all prior resolutions establishing designated business vending areas on public property, and shall be effective on the date of adoption.

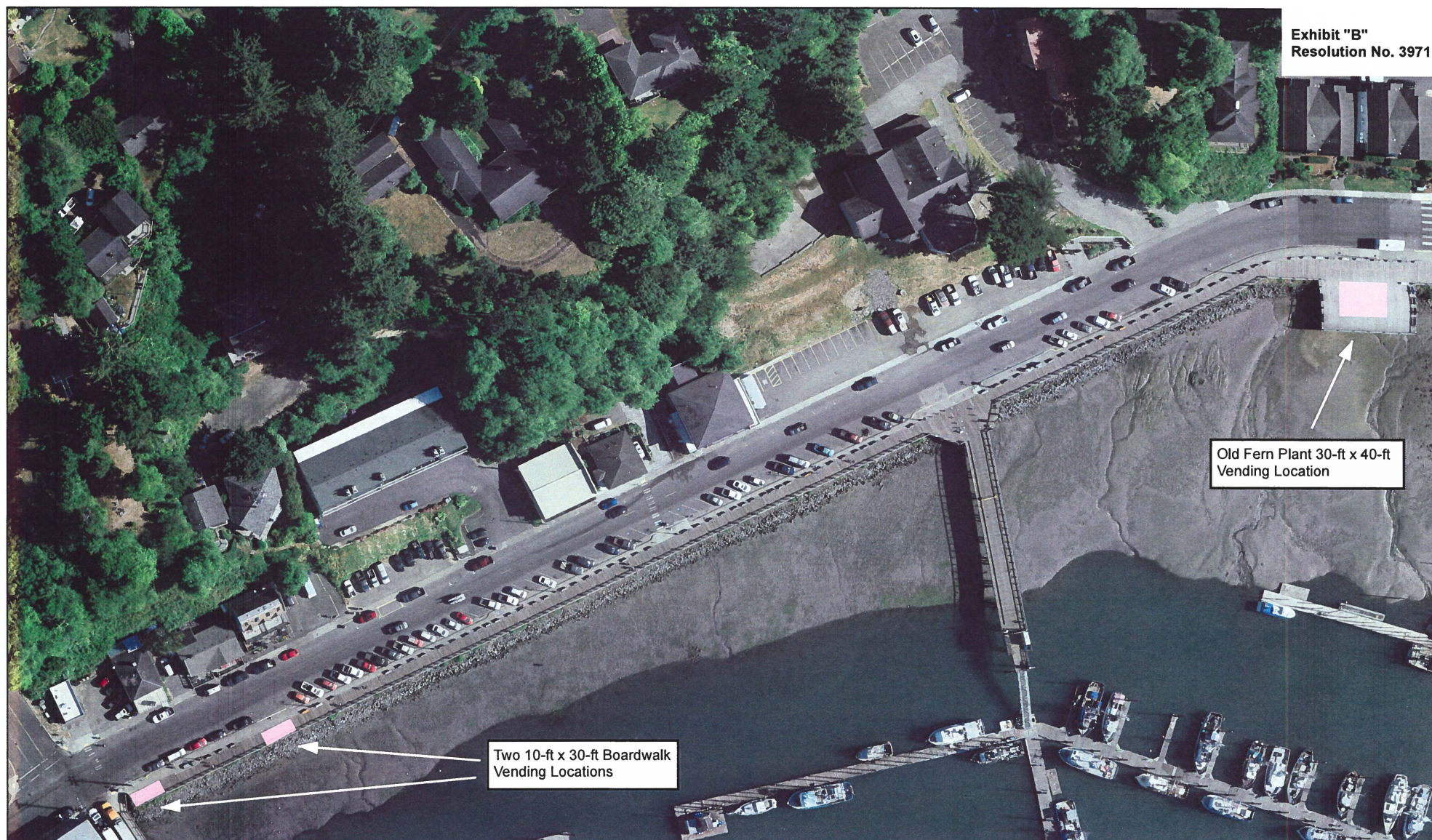
Nye Beach Temporary Fixed Stand Vending Location
