Funding from U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Brownfield Coalition Assessment Grants is available to support redevelopment of underutilized sites within the Yaquina Bay Community. The funding can be used for environmental site assessments (ESAs). ESAs determine if contamination is present, and to some degree, the extent of the contamination present at a property. The assessment provides answers to many of the questions regarding potential cleanup costs and environmental liability associated with brownfield properties. ESAs include the collection of environmental sampling data to assess conditions, evaluates risks to human health and the environment, prepares for cleanup planning, and facilitates property transfers and redevelopment.
