

The city's water main flushing program is scheduled resume next week within the area highlighted in red on the image. Public Works crews are working to create as little interruption as possible to water usage for community members, businesses, and organizations.

Community members may experience water discoloration and decreased water pressure while the flushing is taking place in their area. Flushing a water main on a single street may take up to one hour. If your water appears dirty after the designated flushing period, it is recommended to take the following steps and precautions:

- Run a cold water tap for a few minutes up to 15 minutes or until the water runs clear.
- If you inadvertently drew discolored water into your home and the staining of clothes or fixtures does occur, rust removal products are available at most home products stores.

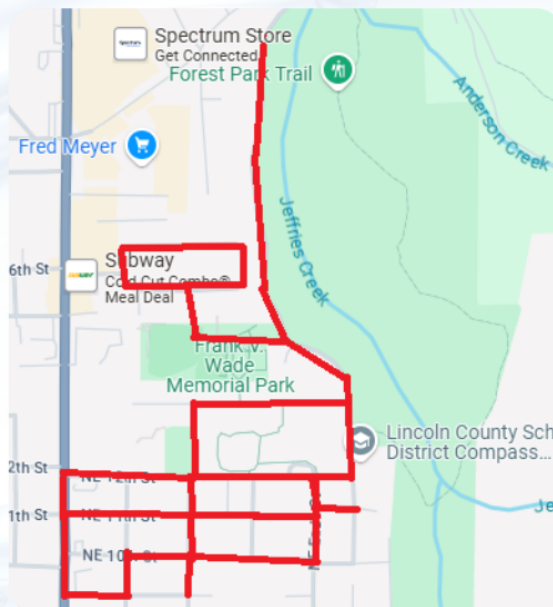
WATER MAIN FLUSHING PROGRAM
