






Runway end 16 Part 77 Airsurface







Newport Municipal Airport Approach Surface Obstructions




Runway 16 – Precision Instrument Approach



Runway end 34 – Non-precision Instrument Approach




Runway end 20 – Visual Approach




Reduced Study Area for NEPA Document

2021 Study Area – Approach Surfaces




2018 Study Area – All Surfaces
